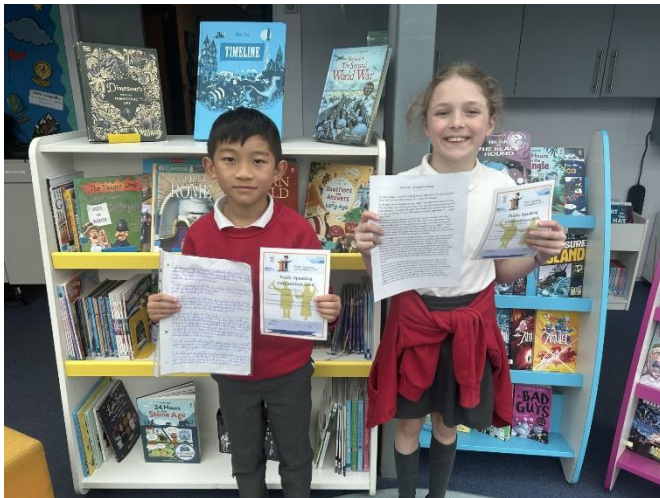

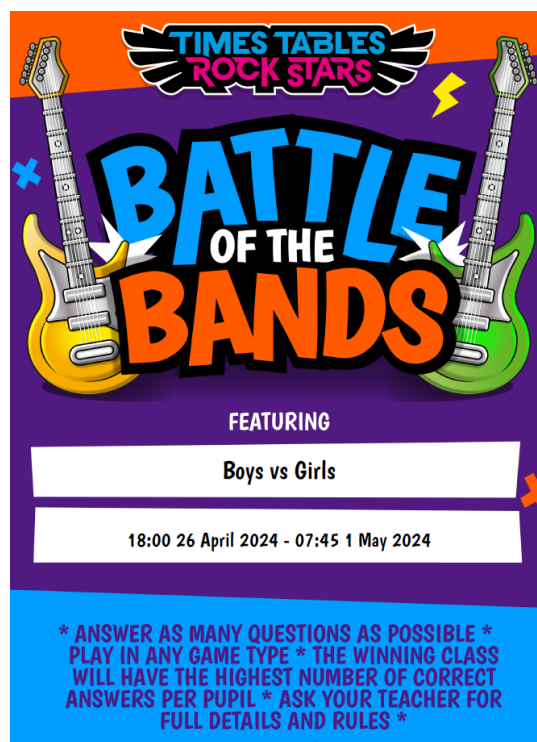

Please ensure hair accessories are kept to the minimum and appropriate for school. We have recently seen an increase in large fashion bows being worn.



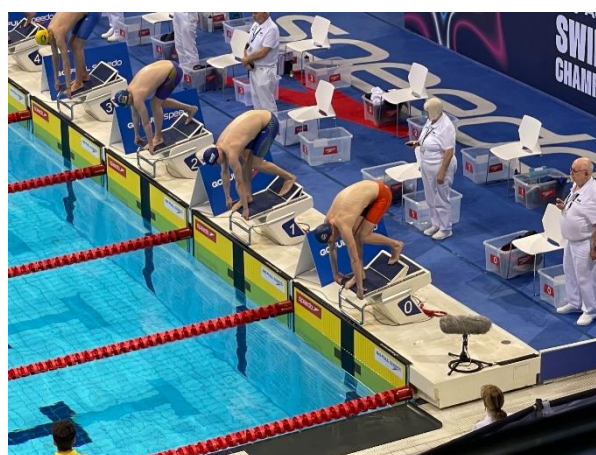
Curriculum overviews
