

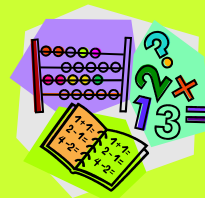
PARKING

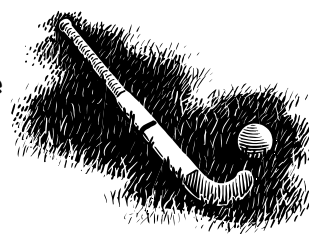
WHAT DO PUPILS DO WHEN THEY'RE NOT AT SCHOOL?
