Topics: Teeth and Rainforests

*Means collect a sheet from your teacher



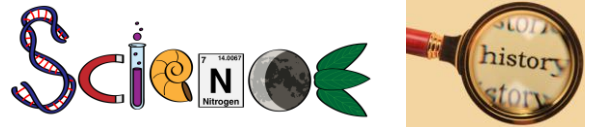
Maths

- Find 5 things around your house to measure the perimeter of. Take photos or draw pictures. (For example, coaster, chopping board etc)
- Using a catalogue, choose 5 items. Put them in order from cheapest to most expensive. Add together the cheapest and most expensive items.
- Do some cooking or baking! Weigh and measure the ingredients. Take photos. Ask an adult to help you!



English

- Reading comprehension task based on rainforest animals. (Internet access required) *
- Write a book review of any book you have read at home. It can be a fiction or non-fiction book. If you would prefer to do this on a sheet* to help you, please collect one from the Base.
- A rainforest wildlife vocabulary sheet* (dictionary required).
- Write a postcard from the rainforest. Describe what you see, hear and smell.



Other Subjects

- Make a rainforest animal out of anything!
- Draw or list items you would take on a rainforest expedition. Say why you would pack each item.
- A teeth wordsearch.*
- Make a poster about an endangered rainforest animal. Explain what deforestation has done to its habitat.
- Make a 3D model of the rainforest layers e.g. in a shoebox.

Complete one piece of homework each week. Try to choose at least one from each subject list. Bring your homework to school on a Thursday.
