Topics: Ancient Egyptians

Maths

- Make a simple game to help you to learn a times table you are stuck on.
- Look around you for examples of 2 and 3 digit numbers. Take photos or write the numbers down and partition them eg 267, a door number, 2 hundreds, 6 tens, 7 ones.
- Place value game.*
- Rocket Race game (a bit like 'Shut the Box) to practise adding.*
- Make a poster explaining how to do column addition. (2nd half term)

English



- Write and illustrate a poem on the theme of Autumn.
- Crack the Code - Egyptian hieroglyphics. *
- Ancient Egyptian Dictionary Matching Activity. *
- Write a book review of any book you have read at home. It can be a fiction or non-fiction book. If you would prefer to do this on a sheet to help you, ask your teacher.
- We will be learning about Tutankhamun this term. Can you choose a different pharaoh to research, and then produce an information sheet.

Other Subjects



- Make something Egyptian! For example a sarcophagus, a pyramid, jewellery etc
- Design a Tutankhamun Death Mask.*
- Design and make a shadow puppet.
- Write a list of how many different sources of light you can find in your house and garden. Remember to use commas correctly!
- Research materials around your home using a magnet - can you make a list of items that are attracted to a magnet and a list of items that are repelled?

Complete one piece of homework each week. Over the term, try to complete at least three from each subject list. Bring your homework to school on a Thursday.

As well as the Home Learning Menu above, you will be given spelling homework each week. Remember to keep learning your times tables and read regularly at home too!
