Maths


- Write 4 simple word problems involving multiplication. They need to be simple because they will be given to Y2 children to solve. Please provide answers on a separate piece of paper.

English

- Reading comprehension task based on Teeth. *
- Write a book review of any book you have read at home. It can be a fiction or non-fiction book. If you would prefer to do this on a sheet* to help you, ask your teacher.
- Find an unusual place to read a book. Get someone to take a photo of you doing this!
- Write a poem or song about a specific river or rivers in general.



Other Subjects



- Keep a food diary for a week. Record which food groups your meals come from.
- Plan a healthy balanced menu for a day, choosing food from each of the food groups.
- Cook something healthy with an adult. Take photos of what you made and write about the ingredients you used and which food groups they are from.
- On a map of the UK, plot places you have visited and label them. *
- Make your own version of an Arcimboldo style picture. Don't make a face like we did in class; also try other ideas, eg plants and flowers.
- Make a factsheet about a European river.
- Make a 3D model of a river showing the different parts that we learnt about in Geography.
- Make a poster to show the parts of the body we have learnt in French.

Complete one piece of homework each week. Over the term, try to complete at least three from each subject list. Bring your homework to school on a Thursday.
