(week beginning 30th March)

Hello, we hope you are managing to keep busy at home so far. We have been making sure we get out into our gardens for lots of fresh air and to make the most of the sunshine. We miss you all and really hope we manage to get back to school before you leave year one.

There are some tasks we would like you to try to do every day, just for a short time. 15 minutes would be really good if you can manage it.

- Use Spelling Shed to work on your spellings
- Visit Hit the Button to work on some maths skills, the number bonds and addition and subtraction games are really good. Some work on doubling and halving would also be useful. You can either download the app or you can access it online.
- Visit www.phonicsplay.co.uk tricky trucks and flashcards are really good and you should be working on phases 3,4 and 5. They have created a free login for parents.
- Read a book
- Complete the Joe Wicks daily workout

We are also going to be setting you daily tasks from now on to help you have some structure to your learning. There will be a Maths task and an English task for each day.

Day	Maths	English
Monday	Visit White Rose Maths, watch the daily tutorial and complete the daily task. whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/	Read one of your books from home together and make a story map of the story. Make sure you add labels and maybe some important bits of speech in a speech bubble.
Tuesday	Visit White Rose Maths, watch the daily tutorial and complete the daily task.	Using the story you read yesterday write a character description for one or two of the characters.
Wednesday	Visit White Rose Maths, watch the daily tutorial and complete the daily task.	Today we would like you to act out the story. You could use your toys as the characters, make Lego models of them or draw pictures and turn them into characters.
Thursday	Visit White Rose Maths, watch the daily tutorial and complete the daily task.	Today we would like you to rewrite the story you have been working on. Think really carefully about how you use capital letters and full stops. Make sure you have finger spaces. We would like you to add adjectives to describe things in the story too.
Friday	Visit White Rose Maths, watch the daily tutorial and complete the daily task.	Today we would like you to visit BBC Bitesize. Search for 'Who was Christopher Columbus?' We would like you to write 5 facts about him, you can display this in a way of your choice. There are also lots of activities on the website for you to try.
