	English	Maths	Topic
Monday	Watch a film of your choice. Do not chose one that already has sequel.	White Rose Maths Week 12 Lesson 1	Write your own end of year report. Remember to think about all of the different subjects and topics you have studied this year.
Tuesday	Write a film review about what you watched yesterday. Wednesday	Think about a potential sequel to the film you watched yesterday. Introduce 3 new characters. Plan this out in a story board format.	White Rose Maths Week 12 Lesson 3	Guess who? Research a historical figure and write some facts down about him/her. These could range from appearance, achievements, family, country of origin, age etc. For those in school usually, please bring these into school tomorrow so we can try and guess them.
