



SEBERT WOOD PRIMARY SCHOOL AGREES TO:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs
- Contact you if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until test comes back negative
- Communicate between home and school through email, phone and the school website.

PARENT/CARER AGREES TO: To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 10 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- I will take responsibility for my child when entering and moving around the school site and I agree to follow all appropriate social distancing measures. I will explain to my child about social distancing but I understand that for a child they are difficult to follow and my child may not always do this successfully
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- On my way to school and when dropping/collecting my child, I will adhere to the social distancing rules
- I will strictly adhere to the school timings for my child
- My child will not bring any items into school with them other than a packed lunch and water bottle *(for essential medication/sanitary items please notify the school office)*
- I will explain to my child that they will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene
- I will not be allowed into the school building without first contacting the school in advance - for matters of sufficient urgency that cannot be explained via email or phone.
- I will support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this pandemic
- I will read all updates/emails that are sent home
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes in circumstances or if our emergency contacts details change
- If my child is deemed unsafe, including behaviours such as spitting, licking or ignoring personal space he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe. *(The pupil's age and needs will be taken into account).*

CHILD

- I will follow the social distancing rules in class, around school and in the playground
- I will follow good hygiene rules:
 - coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it)
 - wash my hands with soap and water for 20 seconds/ and use hand sanitiser
- I will tell an adult if I feel unwell
- I will only bring my packed lunch and water bottle into school
- I will only come in and out of school through the gate I have been told about
- I will behave well at all times to keep everyone safe
- I will follow these rules and know that if I don't, I can be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
