

# Y4 Home Learning Menu Autumn 2nd Half Term 2024

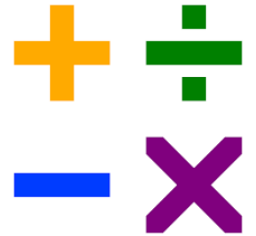
## Topics: Living things, Italy and volcanoes, Pop Art.

\*Means collect a sheet from the blue 'Homework Sheets' tray in the base.

When selecting a piece of homework, if you do not understand the process or what is being asked (particularly with the maths), wait another week or two until you have been taught it in school.

## Maths

- Missing number, column addition. Use your knowledge to try and work out the missing number, you may have to work backwards for some! \*
- Missing number, column subtraction \*
- The multiplication and division facts mosaic. Use your tables knowledge to colour each square in the correct colour.\*
- The Emoji Code Breaking sheet, follow the clues to create the 3 digit numbers and then calculate the answers using column addition or subtraction.\*



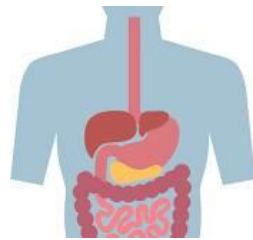
## English

- Collect the reading comprehension sheets from the base all about Italy. One sheet has all the information to read, the others has the questions.\*
- Create and write a postcard pretending that you have recently visited Italy. Describe what you did, saw and experienced.
- Watch either version of 'Charlie and the chocolate factory' and write a film review. You can use the sheet provided for this or create your own. You must rate it out of 5 stars. \*
- Read or listen to a Roald Dahl book and write a book review. You can use the template sheet if you wish. \*



## Science, Geography and Art.

- Pick one country from Europe (excluding Italy) to research and/or use your own knowledge. Write about its landmarks, climate, food and activities you can do there. You could make it look like a page from a holiday brochure.
- Make an Italian dish at home and take pictures. Write an evaluation of what you thought of your dish and what you could do to improve it next time.
- Research 'Pop Art' and find your favourite piece. Who is the artist? Why do you like it? Where is the original on display?  
Download a free app (with permission) such as Picsart Photo editor or Abstract You, and create your own digital piece of art.
- Head outside into your garden and group the animals/ plants you find.



Complete one piece of homework each week. Over the half term, try to complete at least two from each subject list. Bring your homework to school on a Friday.

As well as the Home Learning Menu above, you will be given spelling homework each week to be tested on Thursday's and Mathematics homework will also be set on Friday's. Remember to keep learning your times tables (use Times Tables Rockstars) and read regularly at home too!
