	Item	Action Points / Notes
1.	Outdoor learning area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> JT set the pupils a challenge of researching outdoor learning spaces in other schools- possible names mentioned including 'Eco Hub'.
2.	School Pet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> JT discussed idea of 'chickens' with Eco Leaders. Produce eggs and feed on the waste. Suggestions from pupils for a fenced off area near bike sheds and rota for feeding and cleaning.
3.	Litter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TA- Litter around the school site was discussed. TA is going to organise a litter pick amongst EL's. JM would like to see lids put on the bins if possible.
4.	Blue Bins	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make sure that it is clear which bin is the recycling bin and what goes in it. Suggestion to make new labels.
5.	Litter/recycling posters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make posters to put up around schools about not dropping litter and the importance of recycling.
6.	Gardening club	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mr Tottie to speak to SLT and FOSWS- EG's parent is a gardener so could advise. Mrs Martindale was keen to participate. Herbs and vegetables that could be used in school. Water butt to collect rainwater.
7.	LED lights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> JB pointed out LED lights use less energy.
8.	Fish ponds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BH asked for fish ponds. JT pointed out danger of open water on school site.
9.	Trees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Several pupils interested in planting fruit trees.
