1.	<i>Role and responsibilities</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mr Tottie and Mrs MacInnes discussed the importance of the role and highlighted many of the positive changes School Council have made to our school. Badges will be distributed when the order arrives.</li> </ul>
2.	<i>Clubs</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A wide variety of clubs were put forward by all year groups. Some of these such as chess, netball and athletics have already been established. Mr Tottie confirmed more clubs will become available during the term.</li> </ul>
3.	<i>Pastoral support</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mr Tottie explained how the new 'Green room' is being used to support pupils across the school. A name suggestion sheet to be given out to all classes then agreed by School Council.</li> <li>A suggestion was made for a 'Worry Bench' where playground leaders could help or support those who are feeling upset.</li> </ul>
