	Item	Action Points / Notes
1.	Anti-Bullying Guide	 Pupils worked on a child friendly anti-bullying guide during the meeting.
2.	World Book Day	 Mr Tottie discussed plans for WBD and how the school was focussing on reading for pleasure. We are hoping to invest in new books for each class. Mr Winch and a Year 5 pupil are currently looking into possibility of setting up a book swap scheme.
3.	30 th Birthday celebrations/Summer Olympics	 Mr Tottie explained how this year marks the school's 30th birthday. Pupils would like to mark this with an event/party. Pupils keen to have a 'world' day during the Olympics in Tokyo, where each class represents a different nation. Mr Tottie will liaise with Mrs Hickey, our Geography subject lead.
4.	Outside areas	 Pupils would like more outside seating areas around the perimeter of the field and concept of friendship bench suggested. A water dispenser was requested- this would save pupils having to go indoors to fill up water bottles, especially in the summer.
5.	Eco Leaders	 Mr Tottie explained that Eco Leaders will be carrying out an environmental survey of the school this term. Also they will present information on the energy generated by our solar panels.
