


# Y4 Home Learning Menu Summer 1st Half Term 2021

## Topics: Electricity, The Anglo-Saxons.

### Maths

- Dividing by 10 and 100 sheet. \*
- Fraction Families sheet. \*
- Counting in Hundredths sheet. \*
- Would you rather . . .? sheet. \*



### English and PSHE

- Find a recent photo of yourself. Can you explain how you were physically and mentally feeling in it? Hot/cold, happy/sad. Write as many synonyms as you can (you could always use a thesaurus to help!).
- Find a book or story where a character takes a 'risk', explain what the risk is and how the character must have been feeling.
- Collect a 'Sun Safety' reading comprehension sheet. \*
- Become a journalist and write an article about something that has occurred to your family. Remember that it has to be factual and you could always include quotes. This work can be typed.



### Science and History.

- Go on a sound walk either inside or outside and describe everything you can hear (not just a list). Can you include information on the pitch and sound waves?
- Write a list of all the electrical appliances that you have in your house. Can you list them in order of importance and explain why you think they are more/less important than other items.
- Choose a favourite song/track and write about why you like it. We might even play it in class!
- Find out where the Angles, Saxons and Jutes originally lived in Britain. And research five facts about those regions from either then or now.



Complete one piece of homework each week. Over the half term, try to complete at least two from each subject list. Bring your homework to school on a Thursday.

As well as the Home Learning Menu above, you will be given spelling homework each week and Mathematics homework will also be set. Remember to keep learning your times tables (use Times Tables Rockstars) and read regularly at home too!
